



TWO-DAY ITINERARY

Day One in the Cheese Capital of the World

1. Stop at the Plymouth Chamber of Commerce & Visitor Center to get local information, brochures and menus. (647 Walton Drive)
2. Explore the Plymouth Cheese Counter & Dairy Heritage Museum (133 E. Mill Street).
3. Wander through the newest art exhibit at the Plymouth Art Center (520 E. Mill Street).
4. Snap a selfie in front of Antoinette, our cow statue that stands 20 feet high (Intersection of W. Mill Street and South Milwaukee Street).
5. Drink a pint of locally made brew at Plymouth Brewing Company (222 E. Mill Street) or try a local hand crafted spirit in a specialty cocktail at Plank Road Distillery (601 Eastern Avenue).

Day Two in the Cheese Capital of the World

1. Take a stroll through downtown Plymouth and search for the 25 murals that depict our city’s history. While you are walking up and down our downtown, stop in at the Antique Shops, Boutiques, Music Store, Book Store, Pet Store and more!
2. Discover more on Plymouth’s history with a visit to the Plymouth Historical Society’s Museum (420 E. Mill Street).
3. Stop at Veteran’s Park to view the 11 landmarks with flags representative of the war or conflict each landmark symbolizes (Intersection near Eastern Avenue on Mill Street).
4. Stop for a cup of your favorite caffeinated beverage at The Hub Studio Café, and browse the local art for sale at neighboring Seranya Studio Boutique. (1611 Eastern Avenue)
